

The Mayor and Council of the City of Abbeville met for a committee meeting on April 3, 2018 at 5:15 P.M., at the regular meeting place, the Council Meeting Room located at 101 North State Street, with the Honorable Mark Piazza, Mayor presiding.

Mayor Piazza stated we are here today for a Committee meeting. We have one item on the agenda and it is the Ordinance Committee chaired by Councilman Wayne Landry.

Councilman Landry stated the item is to amend the mobile home park ordinance. He asked Mr. Funderburk to explain the amendment.

Mr. Funderburk had distributed a document that reflects the current mobile home park ordinance which allows for the permitting and criteria for granting the permits. Below that he has placed the suggested amendments for the mobile home park ordinance. The suggestions are as follows: 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to establish or operate any trailer or mobile home park in the city which was not duly permitted and operational prior to June 1, 2018. 2. Existing trailer or mobile home parks shall comply with all pertinent provisions of this Code, including, but not limited to those pertaining to signage, landscaping, heritage trees, drainage, and building codes. The first one would not allow any new mobile home parks to be permitted after June 1, 2018.

-01 introduced by Mr. Brady Broussard, Jr. and seconded by Mr. Francis Plaisance to recommend to the City Council to adopt an ordinance to amend the mobile home park ordinance at their next meeting scheduled for April 17, 2018. The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business to discuss, Mayor Piazza declared this meeting adjourned.
