

The City Council of the City of Abbeville met in special session on October 11, 2017 at 5:00 P.M., at the regular meeting place, the Council Meeting Room located at 101 North State Street, with the Honorable Francis Plaisance, Mayor Pro-Tem, presiding.

*Councilman Plaisance stated that we are here to discuss one item. It is to waive the noise ordinance to allow Abbeville General Hospital to pour a concrete slab for their expansion beginning at 3:00 AM on October 12, 2017, weather permitting.*

*Councilman Broussard stated that the hospital is in Councilman Touchet's district. He is not here tonight but he gave his blessing for this. He agreed it was reasonable for us to do this in his district. Also, the contractor has requested an earlier start time of 1:30 AM but this is something that we cannot do because the agenda was published with the time of 3:00 AM. Since this is a special meeting, by law, we cannot deviate from the agenda. There is nothing wrong with the set up to occur prior to 3:00 AM as long as the pour doesn't start before 3:00 AM. Mr. Dupont stated it should take five to six hours to complete the pour. The loudest noise is when the drum is spinning the concrete. They will be pouring about 200 yards of concrete.*
