

The Mayor and Council of the City of Abbeville met for a committee meeting on September 18, 2018 at 5:15 P.M., at the regular meeting place, the Council Meeting Room located at 101 North State Street, with the Honorable Mark Piazza, Mayor presiding.

Mayor Piazza stated we are here for our Committee meeting. The committee is the Ordinance Committee chaired by Councilwoman Terry Broussard. He turned the floor over to Councilwoman Broussard.

Councilwoman Broussard stated we are here to discuss an ordinance to amend the food truck ordinance by adding Section 57 (exception to the permitting process). She turned the floor over the Mr. Ike Funderburk.

Mr. Funderburk stated that we have in the past adopted a mobile food truck ordinance where we regulate the number of food trucks that can operate in the City and it gave a process for them to go through to get a permit. Councilman Touchet requested that we make an exception to the permitting process for a local vendor who is at a public or private school. He proposes to add Section 57 to the food truck ordinance. It states that if you are a mobile vendor who otherwise complies with all the restrictions mandated by Section 10-55 hereof, is exempted from the permit requirements of this Division if you will be located on the campus of a public or private school, and for the purpose of providing food for an event sponsored by the said school and they are serving only those persons who are authorized to attend said event.

-01 introduced by Mr. Brady Broussard, Jr. and seconded by Ms. Terry Broussard to recommend to the City Council to adopt an ordinance to amend the food truck ordinance at their meeting scheduled for October 2, 2018. The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business to discuss, Mayor Piazza declared this meeting adjourned.
