All applicants must be at least 18 years of age and be a registered voter. A High School Diploma or GED, is required. Must have a valid driver's license or obtain valid driver's license within 6 months of employment.

DUTIES

This is physically demanding work involving manual labor, primarily outdoors under varying weather conditions. The work requires little or no manipulative skill or previous experience in order to do an effective job.
